LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

To whom it may concern:

It is my pleasure to write this letter in behalf of Adam Kugel. Adam was the general contractor in partnership with Hubbard and Sons contractors formed for the purpose of building a 28,000 plus square foot school for the Seventh-Day Adventists in Lewis County.

Adam and his partner were involved early on at school board meetings during the design phases providing valuable input into the ultimate finished design.

The project was completed and occupied in October of 2011. It consisted of a two story classroom wing housing pre-school/kindergarten through tenth grade, a full size gymnasium, music room, full sized kitchen, shower rooms, offices, work areas and storage. A large pump house and a fire water storage tank were constructed on the west side of the building.

Adam and his partner overcame some serious site soil conditions which extended the time of completion by several months. A two-tiered asphalt parking lot was constructed in front of the building to take advantage of difficult soils conditions that would have necessitated importing large amounts of fill.

The quality of the work was excellent. The work crews were conscientious and worked diligently, cooperating with volunteer crews from the church in every way.

Most of the cost over-runs on this project were due to the extensive soils remediation.

The clients are very happy with the school going into their second year. I am personally very pleased with the final project and the close association I had with Adam, his partner, their crews and the client.
